

LITURGICAL COLORS

The colors shown here are the traditional colors of the church season. White (where dates appear on a white background) stands for purity and the festivals of Christ. Purple is for royalty, repentance and suffering. Red represents the Pentecostal fire of the Holy Spirit, the blood of Christ, and the blood of the Martyrs. Green is used for days which have no special season and signifies growth. During Holy Week at the close of Maundy Thursday, the church remains bare (gray) until Easter.
