PEWEE VALLEY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH PASTORAL INTERN POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position is for a person interested in pastoral responsibilities in a team ministry geared to life in a congregation. **Primary responsibilities involve ministry with members of all ages.** The different assignments seek to address various experiences in the life of a church. **This position includes worship, education, and pastoral care opportunities.** The intern will participate with the staff in its full ministry under the regular supervision of the Pastor.

A typical week might conform to the following model (hours and assignments somewhat negotiable):

Sunday (7 hours)

- 1. Involvement in Sunday morning Christian Education activities for all ages.
- 2. Attend fellowship "half-hour" and worship. Seek out visitors and other church members.
- 4. Lead liturgy monthly for regular worship or in communion services.
- 5. Work with Sunday evening Youth Group Fellowship, taking leadership as able.

Weekday Office Hours (2 hours)

- 1. Attend staff meetings as able
- 2. Time with Supervisor (to be scheduled)

Weekday Pastoral Visitations (2-4 hours)

1. This responsibility will become the intern's responsibility after initial contacts and relationships have been established.

Further special project assignments during week (1-3 hours)

Schedule by arrangement with the pastors:

- a) Special worship service leadership
- b) Participation in funerals and weddings
- c) Preaching opportunity

Overall expectations: 14 hours per week
