Christopher Doucot co-founded the <u>Hartford Catholic</u> <u>Worker</u> community in the north end of Hartford in 1993. The Hartford Catholic Worker facilitates the building of community that transcends generational, gender, racial, geographical, and class barriers. It also houses homeless persons, feeds hungry persons, works with children to keep them in school and out of gangs, and resists violence.

Doucot participated in and led nonviolent campaigns in Bosnia, 1993; Chiapas, 1998; Iraq, 1998-2004; Palestine/Israel 2001-2010; Darfur, 2004-2005; and Afghanistan 2011. These experiences have led to several hundred speaking engagements at universities across the United States. Mr. Doucot preaches at several churches (Unitarian Universalist, Episcopalian, Lutheran, and Baptist) across Connecticut.
