## Lenten Activity: Walk the Louisville Seminary Labyrinth

Just inside the main gate of the campus, on the open lawn, is the **Louisville Seminary Labyrinth**. The brick-lined pattern is a smaller version of the labyrinth found in the floor of the sanctuary of Chartres Cathedral in France. This ancient labyrinth was constructed around 1220 A.D. in the stone floor of the Cathedral. This labyrinth and similar designs can be found in many forms throughout history, including the Aztec, Hopi Indian, Egyptian, Ancient Greek, and Norwegian cultures.



The Louisville Seminary Labyrinth is open all year round to all who wish to experience this form of spiritual practice. Reservations are not required.
