Beth Herrinton-Hodge and Sherry Arconti look forward to greeting and meeting with students in the ASC as the academic year gets underway. We're a drop-in center so come by during office hours (posted on the front page). We're on the first floor of Schlegel Hall (Rm. 102).

Who we are:

Beth is the director of the ASC. She works 2/3 time and is available on weekdays to meet with students. She is also the campus contact for students needing accommodations for various learning challenges (ADA compliance). bherrintonhodge@lpts.edu

Sherry is our brilliant, funny and wise tutor. She works part-time on Monday and Thursday evenings and has served students in the ASC for almost 20 years. sarconti@lpts.edu

Both Beth and Sherry welcome your emails. Even more -- we enjoy having students drop in to grab a snack and say Hi.

What we do:

The ASC assists students, faculty, and staff with the various aspects of reading, academic writing, critical analysis, and study skills. We can also assist with professional papers, resumes, and reports.

Throughout the semester, ASC conducts Writing Tables workshops on note-taking, organization, assignment planning, developing thesis statements, documentation styles, senior Statements of Faith, and Ordination Exams.

The Center also works specifically with students whose first language is not English and with students needing accommodations for physical or learning differences.

Students who need classroom or testing accommodations due to learning differences should contact Beth Herrinton-Hodge through the ASC as early in the semester as possible. We work with students and professors to communicate accommodations needs. Come see us, and let us assist you with what helps you learn better.

NEW this year -- online scheduling!

We're beginning to implement online appointment scheduling using Calendly. We hope this will help streamline student appointment-setting, allowing you to select when you can meet with either Beth or Sherry. You can pick times when you are available and can specify with whom you would like to meet. As of this writing, Beth has set up her Calendly account: calendly.com/bherrintonhodge

HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE

It is the policy of Louisville Seminary that all full-time/half-time students are required to have health insurance coverage. Some of you already have health insurance. Those who do not may purchase health insurance through the provisions made possible by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (PPACA) via www.HealthCare.gov. Kentucky residents may apply through the Kentucky Health Benefit Exchange at <https://kynect.ky.gov/>.

All students must present proof of health insurance coverage no later than October 1st.

Failure to provide proof of health insurance coverage may jeopardize your continued matriculation at LPTS. You will only need to turn in a copy of the front and back of your current insurance card to the office of the Dean of Students once you have received it from your insurance company.

Should you wish to explore other avenues for obtaining insurance coverage, the following information may be helpful:

There is a great deal of difference in insurance companies, and it mostly depends on your wellness situation. You can go ahead and apply to a company online just to see if there are any restrictions on your health that would adjust the premiums. You do not have to purchase the insurance; just fill it out to get a quote.

FYI ONLY:

Part of the recreation center fee that is charged to student accounts provides Louisville Seminary students and their dependents access to the H. Hart Hagan Health Clinic at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. The clinic provides a variety of services, including immunizations and school physicals, allergy shots, and treatment of minor health problems. A physician is available daily to attend to the health needs of students and their families.

Although the H. Hart Hagan Clinic of the Southern Baptist Seminary does not fulfill the health insurance requirement, it can be very helpful in meeting some health care needs. [Click here](#) for a more detailed description of services, prices and payment policies.
