

# Remote Access and Use of Commentaries (Ebooks) and the ATLA Religion Database for Exegesis



If a database asks for a user name and password:

User name = the bar code on the back of your student/employee ID.

Password = the last 4 digits of your phone number. Remember that you may have given us a different phone number when you first got a card. Try older numbers if your current one doesn't work.





**Step 9:** The search for *Exodus* Chapter 1, verse 1 retrieved 199 results of which have some commentary or interpretation. Applying limits of full text reduced the number to 83, scholarly journals reduced it to 75, and language English to 54. The results are sorted by relevance and if you want, sort them by newest first. Dates are also available as limits.
