A Pictorial Guide

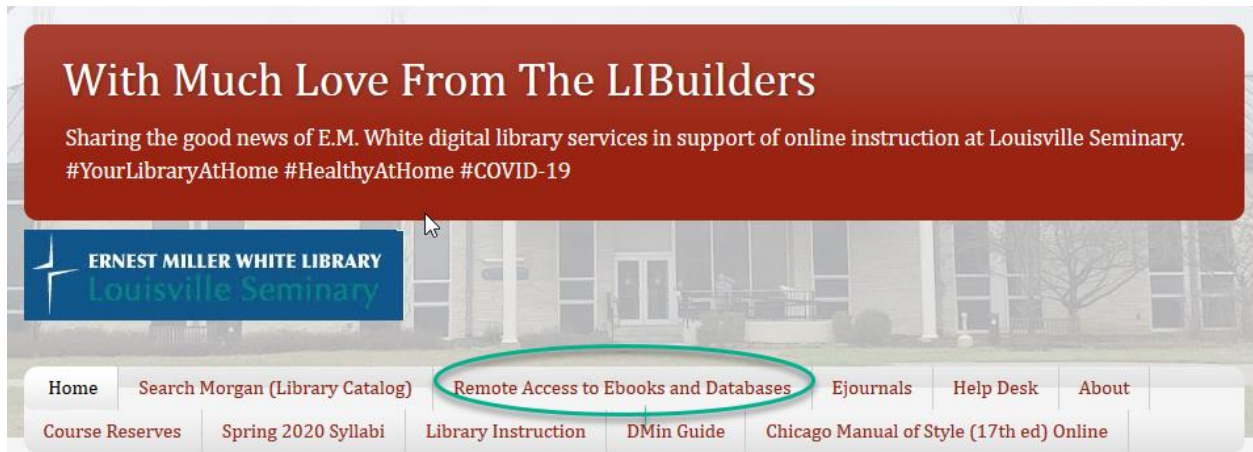
## ABSTRACT

It shows screenshots and lists the steps to find full-text scholarly journal articles that can help in the exegesis paper on Luke 9: 28-36. It uses the Scripture Authority Search in the ATLA Religion Database. Additional resources for How To Remote Access video tutorial are also listed at the end. 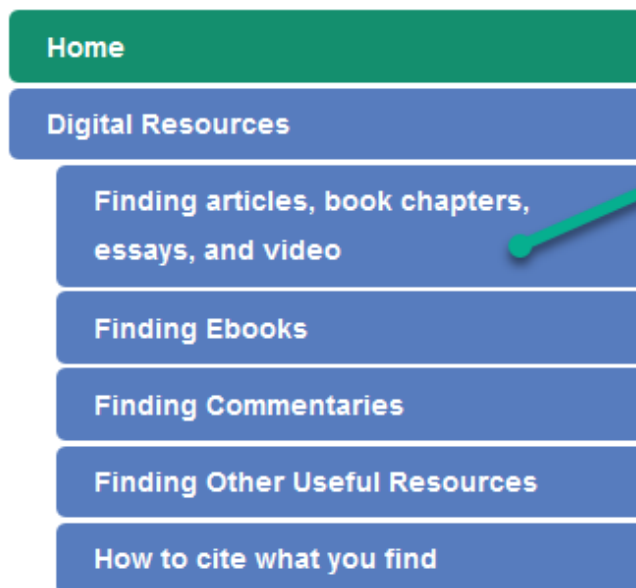
1. To find articles Bible passages or subjects go to [lptslove.org](http://lptslove.org) and click on the link to Remote Access to Ebooks and Databases as shown below.



2. This will take you to the Digital Resources Guide (or go there directly at: <https://lpts.libguides.com/digitalresources>)

3. When you click on Finding articles, book chapters, essays, and video you will see the link to the ATLA Religion Database.

4. Click on the link and you will go to the log in page for accessing remote resources.

You should be taken directly to the ATLA Religion Database.

5. When you choose Scriptures a list of books of the Bible will appear.

7. To search the Subject you found used for the article above, enter the words just as you see them into the Search box. (Or you can choose them from the Subjects on the side) In this case, since we are interested in the Book of Luke and specifically the passage on Jesus Christ's Transfiguration (Luke 9: 28-36), you can add that term in the next box.

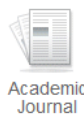
